Widow's Crop Project Update



Thanks to so many of you who contributed to the Plant Hope Crop Project. A total of

\$22,870 was raised to supply 71 widows with improved seed, fertilizer, farming tools, and agricultural education classes. The women began planting in December.

Sponsor a Child!

Our Sponsorship program has grown to 300 children! 113 are still waiting to be matched with a sponsor. Our goal is to have 100% of the children sponsored by September, in time for the beginning of the next school year. Once the

Our effort is for children like her and her family. Our mission is to support indigenous efforts that empower families by providing support for orphaned children, for widows through income-generating projects, and by strengthen entire communities through development projects like wells and libraries.

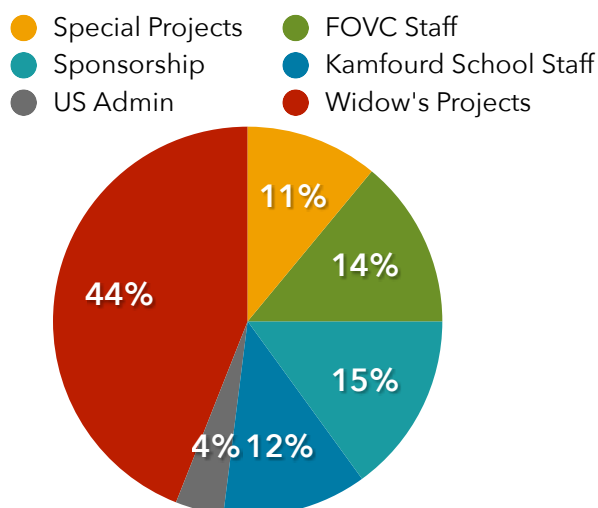

Financial Highlights 2015

Partners With Ethiopia (PWE) supports Friends of Orphans & Vulnerable Children (FOVC) and Kamfourd School in Shanto, Ethiopia. FOVC has two project sites, Shanto and Dale. They are helping 300 children along with dozens of widows. FOVC and Kamfourd School have a combined staff of 42 dedicated teachers and various support staff. We are providing for their salary budget (see "Staff" below).

In 2015, we raised \$79,751! Since PWE is 100 percent volunteer-run, our U.S. overhead was less than 4 percent. We are so thankful that over 96 percent of the donations went to support this great work in Ethiopia. Thank you to all our sponsors, donors, and volunteers!
